REPORT ON THE COMMISSIONER'S REVISED POLICE AND CRIME PLAN FOR NORTH WALES

Background

This report is made in accordance with the Panel's statutory duty contained in Paragraph 28(3) of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011.

Review of Police and Crime Plan

The Panel considered the North Wales Police and Crime Commissioner's revised and updated version of the Police and Crime Plan for North Wales at its meeting on 17 March 2014.

The Panel acknowledged that the Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) had replaced the police and crime objectives in the first plan with four new objectives as follows:

- Prevent Crime
- Deliver an effective response
- Reduce harm and the risk of harm
- Build effective relationships

These objectives were intended to be clear and would give North Wales Police, its staff and its partners a focus and place a greater emphasis on delivering in partnership with other organisations concerned with community safety. The Panel also acknowledged that the objectives would be underpinned by measures, which would enable the PCC to measure the performance of the Police Force.

Recommendations:

(a) That the revised North Wales Police and Crime Plan be supported for adoption.

(b) That monitoring reports be provided to the Police and Crime Panel on a regular basis, on the performance of the objectives within the Police and Crime Plan.
